Learning Ally Audiobooks is an educational platform providing human-read audiobooks and learning resources specifically designed for students with reading difficulties such as dyslexia, visual impairments or other learning differences. It helps make educational content accessible through immersive audio narration aligned with school curricula.

Target Audience

-  **Youth workers:** educators, non-formal education facilitators working with youth facing literacy or accessibility barriers.
-  **Parents:** supporting youth with specific learning disorders (SLD).
-  **Youth:** particularly those with dyslexia, low reading fluency, or visual impairments.

Benefits of this tool

-  Enhances learning accessibility and inclusion by enabling equal participation for youth with reading or visual difficulties.
-  Builds confidence and motivation for students who struggle with traditional reading, fostering independent learning.

Additional Considerations

-  **Multilingual support:** Primarily in English, with limited content in Spanish.
-  **Cost considerations:** Subscription-based model; some schools or institutions offer free access.
-  **Technical requirements:** Available on web browsers, iOS, and Android apps; requires internet connection for streaming or space for offline downloads.
-  **Adaptations for DYS-users:** The tool's human-read audio and synchronized text highlight significantly support DYS-users by reducing decoding stress.



How to Use with Youth

- 1 Create an account at www.learningally.org for educators or students.
- 2 Learning Ally supports individuals with reading challenges and tailors access for parents, educators, adults, and volunteers.
- 3 Browse the library of thousands of titles by subject or grade. Assign or download books for learners or let them choose independently.
- 4 Listen and learn via the app or desktop player with highlighted text to improve comprehension.
- 5 Track progress through the educator dashboard.
