ClassDojo is a communication and motivation platform connecting educators, students, and parents. It supports positive learning environments through visual feedback, behavior reinforcement, and progress tracking, making it especially effective for learners with dyslexia or attention challenges.

Target Audience

-  **Youth workers (teachers):** Teachers can manage classroom behavior and post updates to build connections between home and school.
-  **Youth (students):** Students can use ClassDojo to build personal portfolios, upload their work and reflect on learning. They get recognition for effort, which strengthens motivation.

How to Use with Youth

Create an account: Visit the website www.classdojo.com or download the free mobile app available on Android and iOS. Teachers can sign up with an email address or Google account to create a classroom and invite students and parents.

Parents can join using a code provided by the teacher to connect with their child's class. Students can log in using a class code or QR code shared by their teacher.

Set up your profile: Add your name, role, and class information. Teachers can personalize their classroom with student names and avatars.

Start using ClassDojo:

Teachers can assign points, send announcements, and share learning updates.

Parents can view posts, track their child's progress, and send messages to teachers.

Students can upload assignments, photos, or reflections into their digital portfolios.
