




## Un Mondo in 3D

### Target Audience

- Youth workers
- Parents
- Youth: with SLD, Youth with low digital competences

### Benefits of this tool

- Gives young people with dyslexia practical skills to use digital tools for school and daily life.
- Promotes independence and inclusion by teaching how technology can reduce learning barriers

### Additional Considerations

- Multilingual support:** Mainly Italian.
- Cost considerations:** Some activities are free; others (like workshops or individual support) may require payment.
- Technical requirements:** Uses standard devices (computer, tablet, smartphone) with internet connection. Many tools can also work offline once installed.
- Adaptations for DYS-users:** Focuses on digital compensatory tools that make reading and writing more accessible for dyslexic youth.



## How to Use with Youth

- 1 **Visit the website:** Go to [www.unmondoin3d.it](http://www.unmondoin3d.it) and check the “Compensatory Tools Laboratory.”
- 2 **Join the workshop:** Bring the youth to in-person or online training sessions where experts explain step by step how to use software and apps.
- 3 **Practice with tools:** The youth learns to use text-to-speech, word prediction, or mind-mapping apps for school tasks.
